


## EU Alcohol Strategy - GOALS

- Protect **young people**, children and the unborn child
- Reduce injuries and deaths from alcohol-related **road traffic accidents**
- Prevent alcohol-related harm among adults and reduce the negative impact on the **workplace**
- Inform, **educate** and raise awareness on the impact of harmful and hazardous alcohol consumption, and on appropriate consumption patterns
- Develop, support and maintain a common **evidence base**

### **Clear call for a new Alcohol Strategy from CNAPA high level meeting**

The 9th meeting of the Committee on National Alcohol Policy and Action (CNAPA), which took place in Brussels 17 November 2011, is calling for a comprehensive new EU strategy on alcohol related harm.

A clear call was given from the European Health Ministries of the need for a comprehensive new EU strategy on alcohol related harm. The meeting also confirmed the need to keep on working on the priorities in the current alcohol strategy, and acknowledged the need to continue the coordination of actions in Member States by the Commission.



## Evaluation of the EU Strategy- political reality



No EU Strategy means in reality  
**no priority to alcohol, no funding** for meetings in the EC (no officials in the EC working on alcohol alone), more difficult to get money for projects, etc.



## Evaluation of the EU Strategy- constructive criticism

**Let's be positive where possible, constructive criticism**

– what can be done as next steps, importance of national committee meetings, support of NGOs, conferences etc.

Let's be **critic whenever necessary**, but also let's show the way forward


