

Participatory methods: Group Model Building

- Group Model Building is a method within system dynamics
 - \succ Can include elements of qualitative and quantitative modeling
 - \succ Goal is to generate a dynamic hypothesis around a central, complex problem
 - With stakeholders it can be used to create a shared It's a understanding Fan!





Participatory methods: Group Model Building



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- Engages stakeholders
- ➢Gives participants a voice
- ➤Co-creation process
- Development of a consensus
- Helps identifying why something works/doesn't work



➢Group composition is very important


≻Time!

≻Not easy

- Requires active participation, good modeling and facilitating skills and a basic understanding of the process
- Does not operate in a controlled environment
- ➤Allows for comparing effects
- Different options for implementation



Participatory methods: Group Model Building







Photovoice is a media-based method

 \succ Uses photography and subsequent interviews

 \blacktriangleright Deepens understanding of the lived experiences of

vulnerable populations

 \succ In this case children





Participatory methods: Photovoice





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- Empowers children
- ➤Fun activity
- ➤Helps them explain
- Photos can later be used to explain cases to stakeholders



- ➤Time consuming
- ➤A lot of cleaning up for researchers
- Price of cameras (if you have to buy them)
- Not all children have a smartphone / camera they can use


